What is VPK?

VPK stands for the Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program.

The Voluntary Prekindergarten Education (VPK) Program is a FREE educational program created to prepare every four-year-old in Florida for kindergarten and build the foundation for their educational success. The VPK program offers each child an opportunity to perform better in school and throughout life by offering quality programs that include developmentally appropriate curricula with a focus on early literacy skills, developmental standards, accountability, substantial instruction periods, manageable class size, and qualified instructors.

How many school hours are included in FSIA VPK Program?

- **Summer:** 300 instructional; 9 hours per day are **totally FREE – No registration fee**
- **School Year:** 540 total instructional hours; 3 hours per day are **totally FREE.** 9:00 am to 12:00 Pm / 1:00pm to 4:00pm.
- **FSIA offers the Extended VPK Program**, which complements the 3 free hours, for a full immersion in our learning experience. You can choose between 8:00 am to 4:00pm and 7:00 am to 6:30 pm

What does FSIA Summer VPK Program offer?:

If your child didn't take advantage of the Fall VPK Program, he/she is eligible for Summer VPK Program.

Who is eligible for Florida's VPK Program?

Any child who lives in Florida and who turns 4 by September 1st, 2021 is eligible for Florida's FREE VPK Program.


Recent Changes in VPK Eligibility: A new law extends VPK eligibility for 4-year-olds with birthdays from Feb. 2 through Sept. 1 in a calendar year. Parents can enroll their child in the state's free, voluntary prekindergarten (VPK) education program that year or wait until the following year when their child is 5. This allows parents of younger 4-year-olds to postpone the year their child begins VPK, enabling the child to begin kindergarten and start first grade as a slightly older, more mature student.

Children in Florida are not required to attend either the state's prekindergarten or kindergarten programs but are required to attend school the year they turn 6 by Feb. 1. The new law takes effect July 1.

Four-year-old children with birthdays from Feb. 2 through Sept. 1 will be eligible to enroll in VPK that year or postpone it to the next. Four-year-old with birthdays from Sept. 2 through Feb. 1 are eligible to enroll in VPK the following program year as long as the child has not yet been admitted to kindergarten (please see chart below):

Your child remains eligible until kindergarten admittance, or unless they reach the age of 6 years by February 1 of any program year.

If parents think their child is not ready for Kindergarten:

There are a few points of information to consider:

1. If the child has not attended the VPK program yet and their date of birth falls between February 2nd and September 1st, they qualify for a VPK Postponement.
2. If the child has attended the VPK program, then a VPK Re-enrollment must be submitted along with required documentation to determine if the child is eligible to be re-enrolled in the subsequent program year.
3. A child may only re-enroll in a subsequent program year if:
 - The child attains the age of 4 years old between February 2 and September 1 of his or her initial program year of eligibility; and,
 - The child has not yet been admitted to kindergarten; and
 - The child is granted a re-enrollment



Registration and Enrollment:

For registration and Enrollment in FSIA VPK Program, follow these steps:

1. Register your child for the VPK Program at the following link: www.vpkhelp.org/ Families may register any time before August 15th.

To register, you must have proof of the following:

Proof of age: A child must be four years old on or before September 1st of that school year in order to participate in the VPK Program during that school year, or the following summer. Parents must provide proof of their child's age (for example, an original or certified copy of the child's birth certificate or immunization records).

Proof of residency: Children must live in Florida to participate in any VPK Program. Parents must show proof that the family lives in Florida. Examples of this include a parent's driver's license, utility bill or paystub.

2. Enroll your child in FSIA VPK Program. It's as easy as 1,2, 3:

1. Fill out our Registration Application
2. Bring signed VPK Certificate, and...
3. Bring your child's Blue and Yellow Form (Immunization records)

3. Once you enroll, you will receive a Welcome e-mail with the school calendar year, a copy of our Statement of Policies and an invitation to Smartcare - our online platform where you can see daily photos of your child in school!

Extended Program

FSIA is open from Monday – Friday, from 7:00 am – 6:30pm.
 Extended hours are available as follows:

Part Time: 8:00 am – 4:00 pm (FREE 3 hours of VPK + Lunch + Snacks + 3 Enrichment Classes)

Full Time: 7:00 am – 6:30 pm (FREE 3 hours of VPK + Lunch + Morning Snack + Afternoon Snack + F3 Enrichment Classes)

What to wear:

We understand that children need to be in comfortable clothes, appropriate for indoor activities. For their safety, sandals, flip-flops, jellies, or boots may not be worn to school. We recommend that all children wear sneakers. To foster independence, we encourage children to use clothing that they can easily manipulate. School uniform is mandatory for VPK Extended Program. It is not mandatory for VPK Only Programs.



What to Pack?

Children can bring a re-usable, spill-proof water bottle. Extra snacks from home are allowed, always peanut-free and healthy options. If you need ideas for snacks, please feel free to ask us!

VPK Attendance Regulations:

VPK is a FREE program. 540 hours must be completed during the Fall School Year. Absent days are permitted, but regulated with a daily classroom attendance that must be signed by parents every month. A prolonged amount of absences could result in the finalization of the FREE VPK program and families would need to re-apply with Early Learning Coalition in order to continue the program.
